Professional Grade tube watercolors

- Good choices of brands include:
 - o Winsor Newton, Holbein, Daniel Smith, M. Graham
- Recommended Colors: Please note that these are colors with which I work. You may have colors in your paint box that work just as well.
 Choose one from color from each line below:
 - Cobalt Blue
 - Permanent Rose or Alizarin Crimson New Gamboge or Quinacridone gold
 - o Winsor blue (Phthalo blue), Antwerp or Prussian Blue
 - Winsor Yellow, Aureolin, or Hansa Yellow
 - Brown Madder or Burnt Sienna
 - o Blue-green, turquoise, peacock blue or Manganese blue
 - o Dioxazine violet (Winsor or Carbazole violet)

Brushes

- Squirrel Mop #6 or similar wash brush
- # 10 or #12 round watercolor brush

Paper

- 140# cold press watercolor paper
- preferably a watercolor block (Arches, Fabriano, Lanaquarelle or Winsor Newton) 9" x 12" or larger

• Use sheet paper of the same above brands and have drawing board on which to tape paper
