

List of Supplies

Class: Water and Woods

Students are asked to bring the following supplies:

- Painting clothes (shirt, pants, shoes, apron, etc.)
- Weather-appropriate outdoor clothing and footwear
- Bug spray and/or sunscreen
- Cellphone with camera or digital camera with screen
- Graphite drawing pencils and eraser
- Reusable bag or backpack for carrying items from nature
- Notebook for taking notes
- Spray bottle (16-32 oz)
- Painting palette knife
- Personal water bottle, lunch, other comforts

The class supply fee will cover the following supplies:

- 24" x 24" stretched canvas
- Acrylic paints and paint brushes
- Bristol and/or watercolor paper
- Charcoal sticks and/or pencils
- Colored pencils
- Gouache paint and paint brushes
- Painting palette and palette knives
- Notecards for reflection activities
- Jars and containers for water collection



Students will take home their painted canvas (partially to fully completed), and all paper drawings and paintings. Other supplies will be available for student use during the class itself.

Learning Objectives:

- Create an abstract, textured, acrylic painting with Lake Superior water and sediment
- Learn painting techniques such as: color mixing and layering, shape and composition, and using smartphone photography to inspire abstraction
- Experience a forest bathing walk
