List of Supplies

Class: Introduction to Calligraphy **Instructor:** Sally Wightkin

Students are asked to bring the following supplies:

• Students will be provided with everything they need to participate fully. However, if anyone has calligraphy supplies, I would encourage them to bring them in. We can experiment with them.

The following supplies will be provided:

- Paper
- Variety of inks
- Various tools (pens, nibs, brushes, pencils)
- Basic book-binding supplies (thread, needles, hand-drill, rulers)
- Each student will receive a 'kit' to use during class and take home. This kit will include:
 - A small folder of information including examples, supply lists, articles, etc.
 - A large-sized broad-edged pen
 - A monoline permanent marker-pen
 - $\circ~$ A variety of paper
 - A small container of walnut ink.

All students will take home their final, bound book.

Expectations of Student/Learning Outcomes:

• By the end of the workshop, students will be able to execute at least one style of the Neuland Hand using a broad-edged pen



- Students will be able to take what they've learned about how a broadedged pen works in general and begin to apply it to other calligraphic hands (on their own or in subsequent workshops).
- Students will learn methods to make their own printing and/or handwriting more expressive, interesting and 'calligraphic'
- Students will become familiar with (or revisit) basic design principles and apply these principles to complete a final project using their acquired calligraphy and design skills.
