

List of Supplies

Class: Tribute Pieces

Students are asked to bring the following supplies:

- All of these tools will be provided but may be in limited quantity so feel free to bring any or all if you have them to limit time spent waiting for tools
- Jewelers saw
- Files
- Pliers & wire cutters (parallel pliers are very handy but jeweler's pliers work just fine)
- Steel anvil block
- Portable bench pin
- Center punch
- Any forging or texturing hammers you like to use
- Drill bits for jewelry
- Optivisor or other eye magnification if you need them
- Personal materials
 - Any tokens of remembrance that pays homage to someone or something. These can include buttons, bottlecaps, fabric, costume jewelry, driftwood, stones/pebbles, broken china, etc.
- Optional: acrylic or spray paint

The class supply fee will cover the following supplies:

Metal choices are personal but for many of these pieces, I choose to work in copper and brass and use silver for accents and for the links of the neck



cuff/chain. I will provide kits of materials that we will all use. The kits will contain the following:

- 6" x 12" sheet of 24 gauge jewelers brass
- Two feet of 14 gauge sterling silver wire
- One dozen 1/0 saw blades
- 6" fine silver tubing (for rivets)

I will also have additional copper and brass wire, sheet and tubing available for purchase but if you wish to use additional silver or different materials, please bring your own to the workshop.

We will learn to make a semi-rigid neck cuff/chain, however, if you wish to use a chain, please provide your own.

Student/Learning Outcomes:

- Explore design, composition, and fabrication techniques.
- Learn about the possibilities at the intersection between jewelry and sculpture.
