Please Bring the Following

- Water-based media of your choice
- Watercolor paper
 - Loose sheets are fine, but a pad is all you need.
- Brushes
 - A variety is best. For our purposes, smaller brushes are key.
- Sketch pad
- Drawing utensils
 - \circ Pencils, eraser, etc.

Students who need to purchase these items, but don't know where to start, can find suggestions and links in **purple text**. Art supplies come in a wide range of prices; a good rule of thumb is you probably don't need the most expensive stuff, but you want to avoid the cheapest stuff. All recommendations are for 'good quality, but not too expensive' level supplies.

These are only suggestions, not requirements!

Water-based media include any of the following. Feel free to bring more than one type!

Watercolors, pans or tubes

- There are two main kinds of watercolors: pans and tubes. They are very similar, and either one will work just fine.
- Both types range drastically- you can get sets of just primary colors, or a much wider range.

Pans

- Angora Watercolor sets are great, very affordable and high quality. Sets of 14, 24, and 36 colors. <u>https://bit.ly/306VxVh</u>

Tubes

Gouache

- Opaque watercolors. Most often used as a compliment to watercolor, but can easily be used on their own.
- A little goes a long way, so if cost is an issue, buy a set with more variety in smaller sized tubes than a set of primaries in big tubes.

Inks

- We'll be doing some studies with black India Ink (provided) but there is a huge range of colored inks that provide brilliant, saturated effects.
- Look for inks that say Waterproof or Water Resistant. My two favorite brands are:

- Get a set, or mix and match. Brands can be mixed together.

Liquid Acrylics

- This is simply acrylic paint at a low viscosity, so that it paints more like a watercolor, but with more versatility.
